RESOLUTIONS ON FIRST READING

House Resolution 76

Representative Bacon introduced House Resolution 76:

A HOUSE RESOLUTION urging the legislative council to assign to an appropriate study committee the topic of off road vehicle helmet requirements in Indiana.

Whereas, Offroad vehicle is a generic term that includes all terrain vehicles, four-wheelers, three-wheelers, quads, dirt bikes, utility task vehicles, side by sides, snowmobiles, and snow machines;

Whereas, Standards for helmet use by motorcyclists and during the operation of other motor vehicles has been established by the United States Department of Transportation under 49 CFR 571.218 since 1979;

Whereas, Protective clothing and gear ensures the safety of ORV drivers and occupants from bodily harm including serious injury; and

Whereas, The legislative council is urged to assign to the appropriate study committee the topic of helmet requirements for individuals who are properly fastened into and restrained by a child restraint system while riding in off road vehicles in Indiana: Therefore,

Be it resolved by the House of Representatives of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. That the Indiana House of Representatives urges the legislative council to assign to the appropriate study committee the topic of helmet requirements for individuals who are properly fastened into and restrained by a child restraint system while riding in off road vehicles in Indiana.

SECTION 2. That the Principal Clerk of the House of Representatives shall transmit a copy of this resolution to State Representative Ronald Bacon for distribution.

The resolution was read a first time and adopted by voice vote.
