REPORTING REQUIREMENT

IC 21-12-16-17

(a) The commission shall maintain complete and accurate records in implementing the next generation Hoosier educators scholarship fund established by section 3 of this chapter, including records of the following:

- (1) The receipt, disbursement, and uses of money from the fund.
- (2) The number of applications for the next generation Hoosier educators scholarship.
- (3) The number and amount of next generation Hoosier educators scholarships that have been provided by the commission.
- (4) Any other information collected concerning the fund or next generation Hoosier educators scholarships awarded under this chapter.

(b) Not later than November 1, 2017, and each November 1 thereafter, the commission shall submit a report to the governor and, in an electronic format under [IC 5-14-6](#), to the general assembly summarizing the records described in subsection (a).

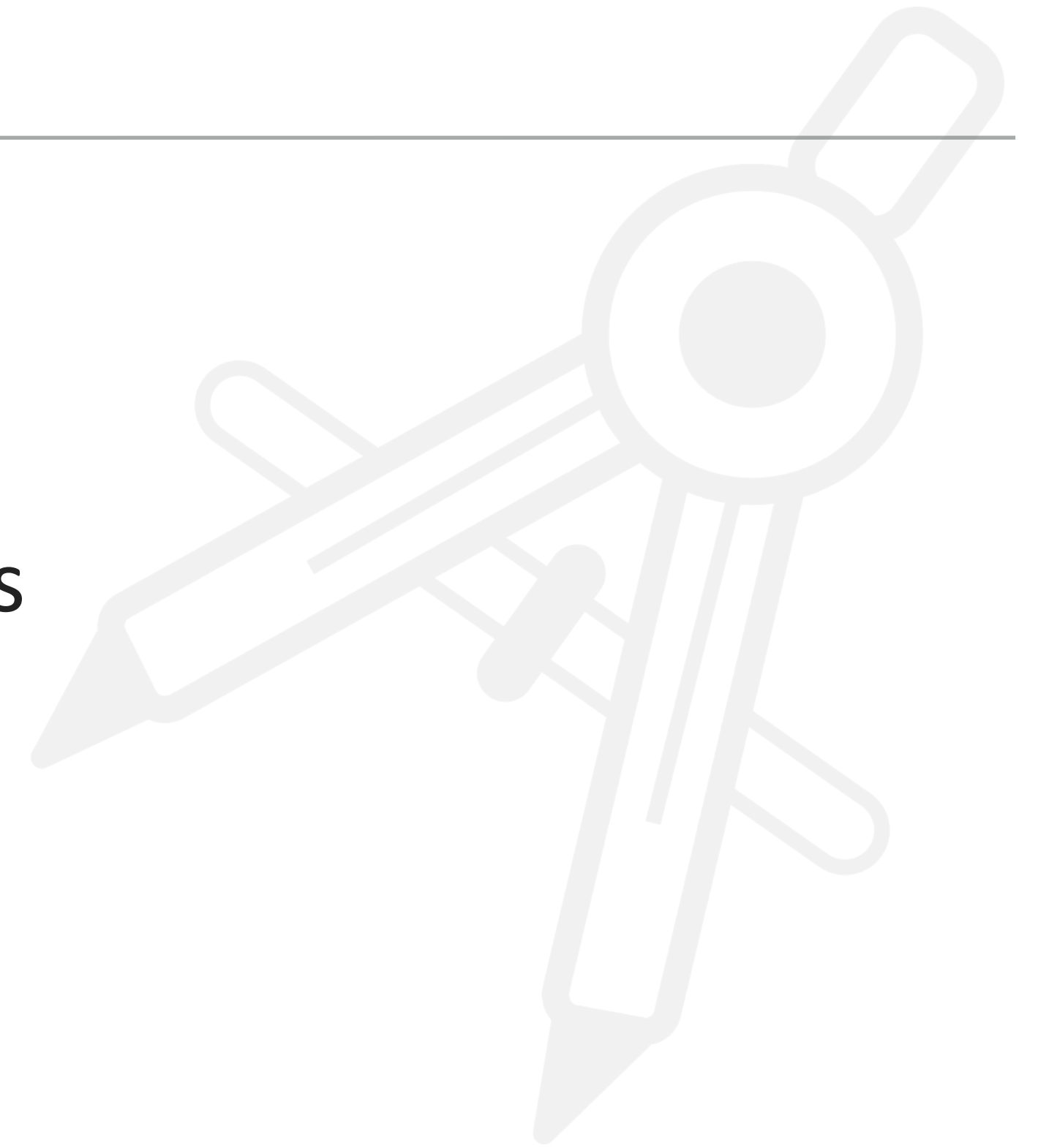

BACKGROUND

- ▶ HEA 1002-2016 created the Next Generation Hoosier Educators Scholarship (NGHES)
 - Provides \$7,500 annually to high-achieving high school and college students who agree to teach in Indiana for at least five years after graduation
 - 200 scholarships are available each academic year



BACKGROUND

▶ Renewal

- ▶ Students can renew up to three additional years while pursuing a baccalaureate degree
 - Must complete 30 credit hours per year, maintain a 3.0/4.0 GPA and other program requirements

▶ Service Requirement

- Must teach at an eligible Indiana school for five consecutive years following graduation

SCHOLARSHIP FUND USAGE



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BACKGROUND

- ▶ The General Assembly appropriates \$6,082,400 annually for the scholarship
- ▶ During FY21 \$4,804,101 was spent on scholarships and \$128,098 on administration
- ▶ The unspent dollars were due to students who graduated early and thus didn't utilize funding

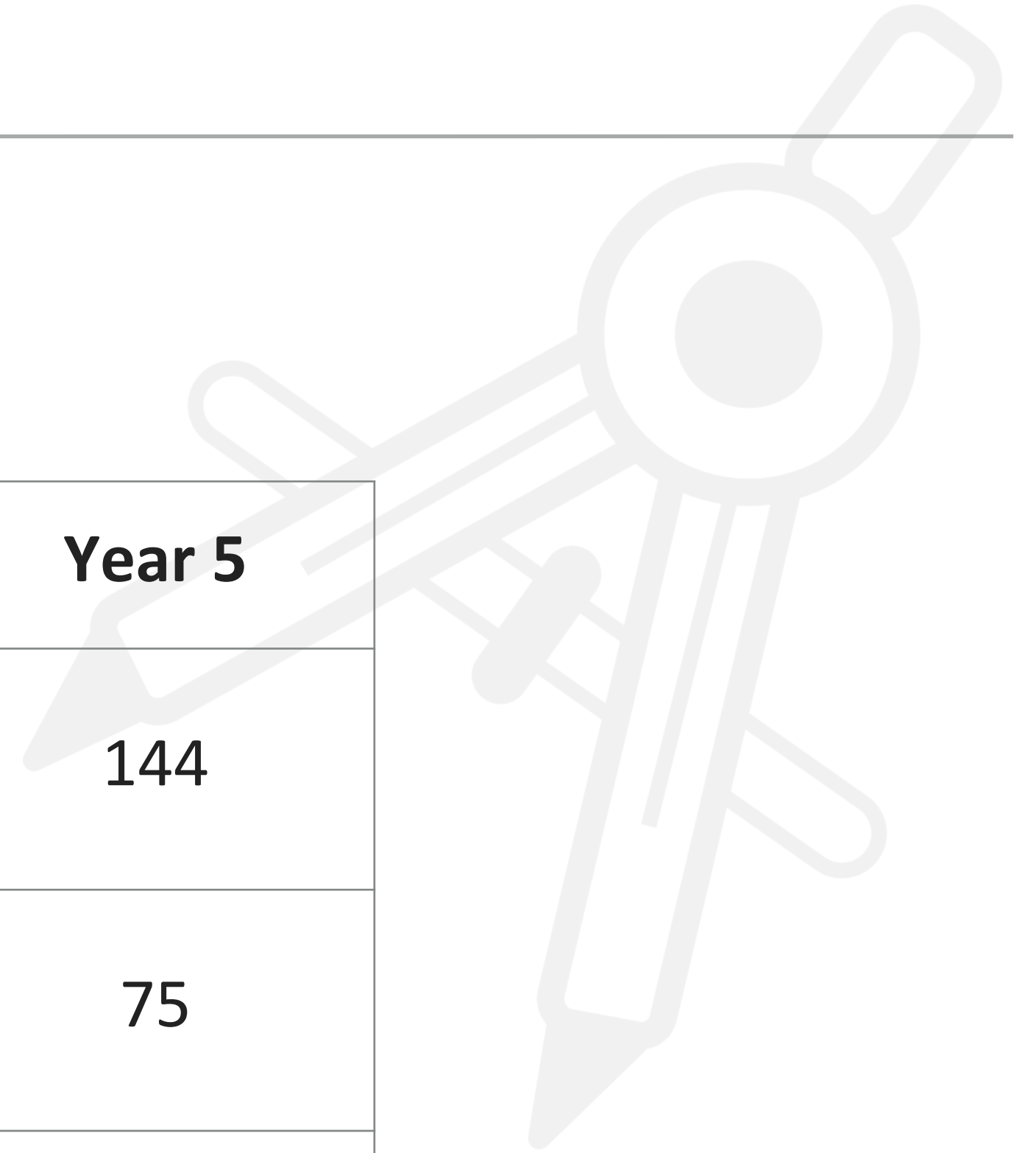
