### Senate Concurrent Resolution 50

Senate Concurrent Resolution 50, introduced by Senator Buck:

A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION urging the Indiana Department of Transportation to name the bridge over Tipton

County Road 600N and U.S. Highway 31 the "Command Sergeant Major Arno C. Land Memorial Bridge."

*Whereas, Command Sergeant Major (CSM) Arno C. Land enjoyed a distinguished 23-year military career that included a Korean War tour and three Vietnam deployments;*

*Whereas, CSM Land was one of the most decorated and bravest combat soldiers in our state;*

*Whereas, CSM Land attained the highest possible rank achievable by enlisted personnel;*

*Whereas, CSM Land received the Purple Heart, the Silver Star, the Bronze Star with three Oak Leaf Clusters, Combat Infantry Badge, Good Conduct Medal - first through fifth award, Army Commendation Medal, Legion of Merit Air Medal, National Defense Service Medal with one Oak Leaf Cluster, Meritorious Service Medal, Korean Service Medal, Master Parachute Badge, United Nations Service Medal, Vietnam Campaign Medal, and Armed Forces Expeditionary Medal - Vietnam;*

*Whereas, A member of the 173rd Airborne Brigade, CSM Land was involved in numerous combat operations, including Silver City, Denver, Dexter, Hardihood, Hollandia, Yorktown, Aurora I and II, Toledo, Atlantic City, Sioux City, Robin, and Attleboro;*

*Whereas, CSM Land was recognized by his fellow soldiers as a "soldier's soldier" and described by a superior officer as "the best combat soldier" he had ever seen;*

*Whereas, His core beliefs about the importance of family and flag touched many lives;*

*Whereas, Born in Windfall, Indiana, on June 23, 1932, CSM Land was raised in Tipton County and returned to his home state upon retirement from the military;*

*Whereas, CSM Land was laid to rest in Arlington National Cemetery; and*

*Whereas, It is proper and fitting to honor the memory of such a brave and dedicated soldier: Therefore,*

*Be it resolved by the Senate of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana, the House of Representatives concurring:*

SECTION 1. That the Indiana General Assembly

commemorates the memory of Command Sergeant Major Arno C. Land and acknowledges his dedication and outstanding service to his state and his country. CSM Land was a shining example of a soldier and patriot whose death left a void that can never be filled.

SECTION 2. That the Indiana General Assembly honors the memory of CSM Arno C. Land by naming the bridge over Tipton County Road 600N and U.S. Highway 31 the "Command Sergeant Major Arno C. Land Memorial Bridge."

SECTION 3. That copies of this resolution be transmitted by the Secretary of the Senate to the family of CSM Arno C. Land and the Commissioner of the Indiana Department of Transportation.

The resolution was read in full and referred to the Committee on Homeland Security & Transportation.
