History:

The Indiana General Assembly created the Licensed Child Care Home Advisory Board pursuant to Indiana Code 12-17.2-2.5. The purpose of each committee is to provide to the division information, advice, and assistance concerning implementation of child care regulations.

Annual Report:

Indiana Code 12-17.2-2.5-6 requires the committee shall annually report to the interim study committee on public health, behavioral health, and human services established by IC 2-5-1.3-4 in an electronic format under IC 5-14-6 concerning the committee's activities during the previous year.

Activities:

The Indiana Child Care Home Advisory Board has appointed voting members but encourages all licensed child care centers to participate in the meetings by offering meetings virtually. The meetings are held quarterly and offered in a manner to encourage maximum participation. The following are a synopsis of activities for SFY 18:

- Discussed that the Indiana University received a grant to work on a project called Best Baby Zone. The grant is to help in the efforts to reduce infant fatalities.
- Discussions around the revision of the Paths to Quality standards.
- Several conversations throughout the year about new federal and state law changes as well as proposed rule changes.
- Discussions about the new structure of the office of Early Childhood and Out of School Learning.
