

# SENATE BILL No. 377

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## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 12-14-30-3.

**Synopsis:** Removal of asset limits for SNAP. Requires the division of family resources to: (1) implement within the federal Supplemental Nutritional Assistance program (SNAP) an expanded eligibility category, that does not consider an individual's value of assets in determining SNAP eligibility; and (2) notify the United States Department of Agriculture of the implementation of expanded categorical eligibility under SNAP.

**Effective:** July 1, 2016.

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A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning human services.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1           SECTION 1. IC 12-14-30-3 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE  
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY  
3 1, 2016]: **Sec. 3. (a) The division shall notify the United States**  
4 **Department of Agriculture and take any other action necessary for**  
5 **Indiana to:**  
6           **(1) elect to participate in; and**  
7           **(2) implement;**  
8 **expanded categorical eligibility within SNAP. In implementing**  
9 **SNAP expanded categorical eligibility, the division may not**  
10 **consider the value of any assets in determining an individual's**  
11 **eligibility for SNAP.**  
12           **(b) The division may adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 necessary to**  
13 **implement this section.**
