

SENATE BILL No. 399

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: White River State Park. Appropriates \$15,000,000 from the state general fund to the Indiana White River state park development commission for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2016. Specifies the permissible uses of the money appropriated.

Effective: Upon passage.

SENATE BILL No. 399

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning state offices and administration and to make an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) **There is**
2 **appropriated to the Indiana White River state park development**
3 **commission fifteen million dollars (\$15,000,000) from the state**
4 **general fund for the period beginning July 1, 2015, and ending**
5 **June 30, 2016. The money appropriated under this SECTION may**
6 **be used by the Indiana White River state park development**
7 **commission, after review by the state budget committee, for:**
8 (1) **land acquisition;**
9 (2) **architectural and engineering fees;**
10 (3) **design fees;**
11 (4) **site development;**
12 (5) **infrastructure improvements; and**
13 (6) **improvements to the park;**
14 **to promote the general health and welfare of citizens of Indiana**
15 **and provide for the creation, development, and facilitation of park,**
16 **exposition, educational, athletic, and recreational projects.**
17 (b) **This SECTION expires July 1, 2016.**



1 **SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.**
