

SENATE BILL No. 151

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 36-7-30.

Synopsis: Excluded city military base reuse authority. Provides that the redevelopment commission of an excluded city in Marion County serves as the municipal military base reuse authority of the excluded city. Provides that a member of the redevelopment commission serves ex officio as a member of the municipal military base reuse authority.

Effective: July 1, 2016.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 36-7-30-4, AS AMENDED BY P.L.42-2011,
2 SECTION 79, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 JULY 1, 2016]: Sec. 4. (a) Except as provided in subsection (c), the
4 five (5) members of a municipal military base reuse authority shall be
5 appointed as follows:
6 (1) Three (3) members shall be appointed by the municipal
7 executive.
8 (2) Two (2) members shall be appointed by the municipal
9 legislative body.
10 (b) The five (5) members of a county military base reuse authority
11 shall be appointed by the county executive.
12 (c) ~~The five (5) members of This subsection applies only to a~~
13 ~~municipal military base reuse authority in an excluded city that is~~
14 ~~located in a county with a consolidated city. The municipal military~~
15 ~~base reuse authority shall be appointed as follows:~~
16 ~~(1) One (1) member shall be appointed by the executive of the~~
17 ~~excluded city.~~



- 1 (2) One (1) member shall be appointed by the legislative body of
2 the excluded city.
3 (3) One (1) member shall be appointed by the consolidated city
4 executive.
5 (4) One (1) member shall be appointed by the consolidated city
6 legislative body.
7 (5) One (1) member shall be appointed by the board of county
8 commissioners.

9 However, at least three (3) of the members must be residents of the
10 excluded city. **consist of the members of the redevelopment**
11 **commission of the excluded city.**

12 SECTION 2. IC 36-7-30-5 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
13 FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2016]: Sec. 5. (a) Except as
14 provided in subsection (b), each member of a military base reuse
15 authority shall serve the longer of three (3) years beginning with the
16 first day of January after the member's appointment or until the
17 member's successor has been appointed and qualified. If a vacancy
18 occurs, a successor shall be appointed in the same manner as the
19 original member, and the successor shall serve for the remainder of the
20 vacated term.

21 (b) ~~In the case of~~ **This subsection applies only to** a municipal
22 military base reuse authority in an excluded city located in a county
23 with a consolidated city. ~~the original members shall serve for the~~
24 following terms:

25 (1) ~~A member appointed by the executive of the excluded city or~~
26 ~~the consolidated city executive shall serve for the longer of three~~
27 ~~(3) years beginning with the first day of January after the~~
28 ~~member's appointment or until the member's successor is~~
29 ~~appointed and qualified.~~

30 (2) ~~A member appointed by the legislative body of the excluded~~
31 ~~city or the consolidated city legislative body shall serve for the~~
32 ~~longer of one (1) year beginning with the first day of January after~~

35 (3) ~~A member appointed by the board of county commissioners~~

39 **A member of the redevelopment commission of the excluded city**
40 **serves ex officio as a member of the municipal military base reuse**

42 (c) Each member of a reuse authority, before beginning the



1 member's duties, shall take and subscribe an oath of office in the usual
2 form, to be endorsed on the certificate of the member's appointment.
3 The endorsed certificate must be promptly filed with the clerk for the
4 unit that the member serves.

5 (d) Each member of a reuse authority, before beginning the
6 member's duties, shall execute a bond payable to the state, with surety
7 to be approved by the executive of the unit. The bond must be in the
8 penal sum of fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) and must be
9 conditioned on the faithful performance of the duties of the member's
10 office and the accounting for all money and property that may come
11 into the member's hands or under the member's control. The cost of the
12 bond shall be paid by the special taxing district.

13 (e) A member of a reuse authority must be at least eighteen (18)
14 years of age and ~~except as provided in section 4(c) of this chapter,~~ must
15 be a resident of the unit responsible for the member's appointment.

16 (f) If a member ceases to be qualified under this section, the
17 member forfeits the member's office.

18 (g) Members of a reuse authority are not entitled to salaries but are
19 entitled to reimbursement for expenses necessarily incurred in the
20 performance of their duties.
