MR. SPEAKER:

*Your Committee on Local Government, to which was referred House Bill 1171, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:*

- 1 Page 3, line 23, delete "The" and insert "**Except as provided in**
- 2 **section 10.2 of this chapter, the**".
- 3 Page 3, line 25, delete "," and insert ";".
- 4 Page 3, line 25, delete "including administrative and".
- 5 Page 3, delete line 26.
- 6 Page 3, run in lines 25 through 27.
- 7 Page 5, after line 4, begin a new paragraph and insert:
- 8 "SECTION 2. IC 36-2-7-10.2 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
- 9 CODE AS A **NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS**
- 10 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2014]: **Sec. 10.2. (a) As used in this section,**
- 11 **"fund" refers to the county recorder's records perpetuation fund**
- 12 **established under section 10(d) of this chapter.**
- 13 **(b) A county recorder may pay all or a portion of the expenses**

1 of the county recorder's office for the following calendar year from
2 the fund only if the county recorder submits to the county fiscal
3 body a sworn statement that:

4 (1) the current revenue to the fund is sufficient to fulfill the
5 statutory purpose of the fund;

6 (2) the technology of the county recorder's office is presently
7 updated and at a level to sufficiently meet the statutory
8 purposes of the fund and the county recorder's office;

9 (3) the fund has a sufficient reserve, consistent with the
10 recorder's plan, to capitalize the next technology or other
11 records management upgrade necessary to fulfill the statutory
12 purpose of the fund and the county recorder's office; and

13 (4) the county recorder specifically requests that all or a
14 specific, identifiable portion of the fund be used to pay the
15 expenses of the county recorder's office for the following
16 calendar year.

17 (c) Upon receiving the county recorder's sworn statement, the
18 county fiscal body may adopt an ordinance approving the county
19 recorder's request. If the ordinance is adopted, the county fiscal
20 body shall, if specifically requested by the recorder for the
21 following calendar year, approve sufficient money from the fund.
22 The county fiscal body may not approve any more money from the
23 fund for any purpose in excess of that requested by the county
24 recorder.

25 (d) A county recorder's request and the county fiscal body's
26 approval are valid for only the following calendar year. The
27 requirements of this section must be met for each calendar year."

(Reference is to HB 1171 as introduced.)
