DIGEST OF HB 1179 (Updated February 17, 2016 2:35 pm - DI 116)

Citations Affected: IC 21-12; IC 21-13.

Synopsis: Minority student teaching stipend. Provides that a minority student who participates in a school administration internship as part of the student's graduate degree program is eligible to receive a stipend from, currently, the student teaching stipend for minorities. Names the student teaching stipend for minority students after Earline Rogers.

Effective: July 1, 2016.

ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1179

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

 2 all renewals and extensions, under any of the laws listed in subsection

 5 must be used within eight (8) years after the date the individual first
 6 applies and becomes eligible for benefits under the applicable law.

15 **(A)** student teaching as part of the student's degree
 16 requirements; **or**

17 **(B) a school administration internship as part of the**
 18 **student's graduate degree program;**

19 (3) has earned a cumulative grade point average upon:

20 **(A)** entering student teaching; **or**

21 **(B) beginning a school administration internship;**

22 of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale, or its equivalent as determined by the
 23 eligible institution; and

24 (4) meets any other minimum criteria established by the
 25 commission.

26 SECTION 3. IC 21-13-8-2, AS ADDED BY P.L.205-2013,
 27 SECTION 329, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
 28 [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2016]: Sec. 2. (a) A student who has applied for
 29 the stipend under section 1 of this chapter and has been approved by
 30 the commission may request payment of the stipend after
 31 demonstrating that the student will engage in student teaching **or a**
 32 **school administration internship** during the upcoming academic
 33 term. **The commission shall give priority to student teaching**
 34 **applicants when selecting applicants.**

35 (b) The stipend may not exceed:

36 (1) for a student with a cumulative grade point average of at least
 37 3.5 on a 4.0 scale, or its equivalent as determined by the eligible
 38 institution, based on the most recently concluded academic term,
 39 five thousand dollars (\$5,000); **or**

40 (2) for a student with a cumulative grade point average of at least
 41 3.0 and less than 3.5 on a 4.0 scale, or its equivalent as
 42 determined by the eligible institution, based on the most recently



- 1 concluded academic term, four thousand dollars (\$4,000).
- 2 (c) The commission shall pay the stipend directly to the student.
