

SENATE BILL No. 9

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 4-5-1-11.

Synopsis: Motor vehicle wholesale dealers. Provides that the secretary of state may not require by rule that a wholesale dealer must sell a minimum number of vehicles per year. Voids existing rules.

Effective: July 1, 2014.

SENATE BILL No. 9

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning state offices and administration.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 4-5-1-11, AS AMENDED BY P.L.92-2013,
2 SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 JULY 1, 2014]: Sec. 11. (a) The secretary of state may adopt and
4 enforce rules under IC 4-22-2 that are necessary to carry out IC 9-32.
5 (b) **Notwithstanding subsection (a), a rule adopted by the**
6 **secretary of state under subsection (a) that is necessary to carry**
7 **out and enforce IC 9-32 may not require a wholesale dealer to sell**
8 **a minimum number of vehicles per year. A rule that violates this**
9 **subsection is void.**
10 (c) **75 IAC 2-2-10(d)(6), 75 IAC 2-2-11(b), and 75**
11 **IAC 4-2-9(d)(6) are void. The publisher of the Indiana**
12 **Administrative Code and Indiana Register shall remove 75**
13 **IAC 2-2-10(d)(6), 75 IAC 2-2-11(b), and 75 IAC 4-2-9(d)(6) from**
14 **the Indiana Administrative Code. This subsection expires**
15 **December 31, 2014.**
