Summary of Legislation: The bill provides that the Indiana Judicial Center (IJC) shall administer, in consultation with the Department of Correction, the state grants to counties for community corrections programs.

It creates the Justice Reinvestment Community Grants Program (Program), and it provides that the IJC shall develop and administer the program. The bill provides that the board of directors of the Judicial Conference shall promulgate rules for the program.

The bill provides that the IJC shall award grants:

- (1) to assist with the establishment and maintenance of community corrections programs in each county by 2020;
- (2) to assist communities and counties to develop and maintain alternatives to incarceration that are needed in the applicable community or county; and
- (3) to reduce recidivism.

It provides that the IJC shall monitor other state programs that provide funding to programs that are alternatives to incarceration, and it requires the IJC to create reports on the program and other state funding of programs that are alternatives to incarceration.

The bill provides that there is an annual appropriation of \$50 M to the Program.
