HOUSE BILL No. 1312

DIGEST OF HB 1312 (Updated January 19, 2016 12:51 pm - DI 123)

Citations Affected: IC 5-22.

Synopsis: Veteran business enterprises. Defines "veteran", for the purpose of qualifying as a veteran owned small business by the Indiana department of administration, as an individual who: (1) served on active duty in any branch of the armed forces of the United States or their reserves, or served in the Indiana National Guard; and (2) received an honorable discharge from service; or (3) is serving in the reserves of the United States military, national guard, or Indiana National Guard. Requires that a business seeking to qualify as a small business owned and operated by veterans have current certification as a veteran owned small business by the Indiana department of administration. Provides that certain information submitted by an applicant for certification as a veteran owned small business is confidential.

Effective: July 1, 2016.

HOUSE BILL No. 1312

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning veterans.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 5-22-14-0.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3 1, 2016]: **Sec. 0.5. As used in this chapter, "NGB-22" means the**
4 **National Guard Report of Separation form or its predecessor or**
5 **successor form.**

6 SECTION 2. IC 5-22-14-2.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
7 AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
8 1, 2016]: **Sec. 2.5. As used in this chapter, "veteran" means an**
9 **individual who is serving in the reserves of the United States**
10 **military, national guard, or Indiana National Guard or who:**

11 (1) **served:**
12 (A) **on active duty in any branch of the armed forces of the**
13 **United States or their reserves; or**
14 (B) **in the Indiana National Guard; and**
15 (2) **received an honorable discharge from service.**

16 SECTION 3. IC 5-22-14-3.5, AS ADDED BY P.L.90-2013,
17 SECTION 2, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE

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1 JULY 1, 2016]: Sec. 3.5. (a) A business qualifies as a small business
 2 for purposes of this chapter if the business is an Indiana small business
 3 concern owned and controlled by veterans, as defined in
 4 15 U.S.C. 632(q)(3) as in effect January 1, 2013, **or is an Indiana**
 5 **small business owned and operated by veterans (as defined in**
 6 **section 2.5 of this chapter)** and the business:

7 (1) has:

8 (A) a current verification as a veteran owned small business
 9 concern under 38 CFR 74, et seq., by the Center of Veterans
 10 Enterprise of the United States Department of Veterans
 11 Affairs; **or**

12 **(B) current certification as a veteran owned small business**
 13 **by the Indiana department of administration;**

14 (2) is owned and controlled by one (1) or more veterans who have
 15 been residents of Indiana for at least one (1) year before making
 16 an offer or, in the case of a corporation, have at least fifty-one
 17 percent (51%) of the corporation's stock owned by one (1) or
 18 more veterans who have been residents of Indiana for at least one
 19 (1) year before making an offer; and

20 (3) has its principal place of business located in Indiana.

21 (b) The Indiana economic development corporation may assist the
 22 Indiana department of administration in doing any of the following:

23 (1) Compiling and maintaining a comprehensive list of veteran
 24 owned small businesses.

25 (2) Assisting veteran owned small businesses in complying with
 26 the procedures for bidding on state contracts.

27 (3) Examining requests from the Indiana department of
 28 administration for the purchase of supplies or services to help
 29 determine which purchases may be consistent with the goal
 30 described in section 11(a) of this chapter.

31 (4) Simplifying specifications and contract terms to increase the
 32 opportunities for veteran owned small businesses to participate in
 33 state contracts.

34 (c) The Indiana economic development corporation, in consultation
 35 with the Indiana department of administration, may develop programs
 36 to encourage cities, counties, towns, townships, and private businesses
 37 to adopt the goal for contracts with veteran owned small businesses
 38 described in section 11(a) of this chapter.

39 **(d) For purposes of this chapter, information submitted by an**
 40 **applicant for certification as a veteran owned small business that**
 41 **contains:**

42 **(1) personal financial information; or**



1 **(2) confidential business information;**
 2 **is confidential.**

3 **(e) For purposes of this chapter, the following forms submitted**
 4 **by an applicant for certification as a veteran owned small business**
 5 **are confidential:**

6 **(1) DD 214 (as defined in IC 10-17-15-1).**

7 **(2) NGB-22 (as defined in section 0.5 of this chapter).**

8 SECTION 4. IC 5-22-14-11, AS AMENDED BY P.L.53-2014,
 9 SECTION 68, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 10 JULY 1, 2016]: Sec. 11. (a) The Indiana department of administration
 11 shall adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 to do the following:

12 (1) Increase contracting opportunities for Indiana veteran owned
 13 small businesses described in section 3.5 of this chapter with a
 14 goal to procure in each state fiscal year at least three percent (3%)
 15 of state contracts with Indiana veteran owned small businesses.

16 (2) Develop procurement policies and procedures to accomplish
 17 the goal described in subdivision (1), including guidelines to be
 18 followed by the Indiana department of administration in
 19 conducting the department's procurement efforts.

20 **(3) Implement IC 5-22-14-3.5.**

21 These procurement policies do not apply to a procurement of supplies
 22 and services to address immediate and serious government needs at a
 23 time of emergency, including a threat to the public health, welfare, or
 24 safety that may arise by reason of floods, epidemics, riots, acts of
 25 terrorism, major power failures, a threat proclaimed by the President of
 26 the United States or the governor, or a threat declared by the
 27 commissioner of the Indiana department of administration.

28 (b) The Indiana department of administration shall annually
 29 evaluate its progress in meeting the goal described in this section for
 30 the previous state fiscal year. Beginning in 2014, after June 30 and
 31 before November 1 of each year, the Indiana department of
 32 administration shall submit a report to the governor, the Indiana
 33 department of veterans' affairs, and the interim study committee on
 34 public safety and military affairs established by IC 2-5-1.3-4 and the
 35 legislative council in an electronic format under IC 5-14-6. The report
 36 must include:

37 (1) the percentage goal obtained by the Indiana department of
 38 administration during the previous state fiscal year; and

39 (2) a summary of why the Indiana department of administration
 40 failed to meet the goal and what actions are being taken by the
 41 Indiana department of administration to meet the goal in the
 42 current state fiscal year.



1 (c) The Indiana department of administration shall post the report
2 described in subsection (b) on the department's Internet web site not
3 later than thirty (30) days after the report is submitted. The Indiana
4 department of veterans' affairs shall post the report described in
5 subsection (b) on the department's Internet web site not later than thirty
6 (30) days after the report is submitted by the Indiana department of
7 administration.
