SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION 3

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION urging the Indiana Department
2 of Transportation to place a memorial sign where the 38th parallel
3 crosses Interstate 69 just north of Morgan Avenue in Evansville,
4 entitled "Veterans of the Korean War Memorial - 38th Parallel".

5 *Whereas, Indiana's veterans display the spirit of patriotism,*
6 *the love of country, and the willingness to serve and sacrifice*
7 *for the common good, which has always helped to make our*
8 *country and state great;*

9 *Whereas, The Indiana General Assembly recognizes the*
10 *many sacrifices made by Indiana veterans in time of war;*

11 *Whereas, Many states, including Indiana, have designated*
12 *and named portions of state or federal highways as*
13 *memorials to those brave men and women who served their*
14 *country so well in perilous times;*

15 *Whereas, The Korean War began on June 25, 1950, when*
16 *President Harry S. Truman committed the United States*
17 *military to a United Nations effort to stop North Korea's*
18 *annexation of South Korea;*

19 *Whereas, Between June 25, 1950, and July 27, 1953,*
20 *approximately 5,720,000 Americans served in the military,*
21 *many of whom were stationed in Korea;*

22 *Whereas, The Korean War cost our nation dearly, taking*
23 *more than 33,000 lives;*

24 *Whereas, The military personnel involved in this war*



1 *sacrificed greatly for their country but received little thanks;*

2 *Whereas, The people of the state of Indiana and the city of*
3 *Evansville wish to honor the Korean War veterans by*
4 *erecting a memorial sign where the 38th parallel crosses*
5 *Interstate 69, which is just north of Morgan Avenue; and*

6 *Whereas, It is fitting and proper that these brave*
7 *Americans receive the recognition that they so justly deserve:*
8 *Therefore,*

9 *Be it resolved by the Senate*
10 *of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana,*
11 *the House of Representatives concurring:*

12 SECTION 1. That the service of Indiana veterans to our state and
13 our nation during the Korean War be commemorated by urging the
14 Indiana Department of Transportation to place a memorial sign where
15 the 38th parallel crosses Interstate 69 just north of Morgan Avenue in
16 Evansville, entitled "Veterans of the Korean War Memorial - 38th
17 Parallel" in their honor.

18 SECTION 2. That a copy of this resolution be transmitted by the
19 Secretary of the Senate to Don Gillies and the commissioner of the
20 Indiana Department of Transportation.
