**Summary of Legislation:** This bill establishes the Safety PIN (Protecting Indiana's Newborns) Grant Program for the purpose of reducing Indiana's infant mortality rates. The bill establishes the Safety PIN Grant Fund. It requires the Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH) to administer the grant program, sets forth requirements for grant proposals, and sets forth subject matters that will receive preference in awarding the grants.

**Effective Date:** July 1, 2015.

**Explanation of State Expenditures:** This bill establishes the Safety PIN Grant Program and Grant Fund. The fund is to consist of appropriations, state or federal grants, and gifts and donations. However, the bill does not provide funding. If a grant funding source is provided, the bill could increase the workload of the ISDH to process grant application requests. Increases in workload are expected to be absorbed within existing resource and funding levels.
